Following the outcome of inspections, legal proceedings on administrative violations conducted against Surgutneftegas were discontinued on 06.07.2015 (Prirodnadzor of Yugra) and 22.07.2015 (Rosprirodnadzor for KhMAO-Yugra) due to the lack of evidence for the alleged offense.</p> |

Decision to impose administrative sanctions of Prirodnadzor of Yugra on “Surgutneftegas” PJSC was revoked by the Decision of the Court of Khanty-Mansiysky Autonomous Okrug – Yugra due to the unproven circumstances and absence of guilt of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC.</p>  |

Following the outcome of inspections, violation of environmental legislation was not indicated.</p> <p>24.11.2015 - to indicate cases of huts erection (illegally erected buildings and permanent camp sites of poachers) in the area of Sacred Lake Imlor with the participation of Prirodnadzor of Yugra, S.V.Kechimov, representatives of "Surgutneftegas" PJSC and representatives of GREENPEACE. Facts of huts existence were partially proved. According to S.V.Kechimov the period when he detected the said huts was from one to three years. During the inspection, people performing hunting or fishing were not found. Prirodnadzor of Yugra together with S.V.Kechimov decided to remove the huts.</p> <p>Following the outcome of the said inspections, environmental pollution and violation of environmental legislation by "Surgutneftegas" PJSC were not indicated. Taking into consideration the presence of snow cover during the inspection, Prirodnadzor of Yugra planned control inspections for a snowless period of 2016.</p> <p>In May 2016, the huts were removed based on the decision of the working group initiated by "Surgutneftegas" PJSC and comprised of representatives of Administration of Surgutsky District, Surgutneftegas and small-numbered indigenous peoples of the North. Surgutneftegas provided workforce and means to perform the said works.</p> <p>On 20.06.2016 inspection was carried out to indicate cases of overpressure of the natural flow and contamination of land and surface water bodies with the participation of S.V.Kechimov, representatives of Surgutneftegas and representatives of GREENPEACE. Reply No. 12-50/8367-05 of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment of the Russian Federation dated 14.10.2016 stated that the goals set at the creation of Numto nature park were taken into account in the development of new land-use planning of the park. Following project review, the project was approved by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment of the Russian Federation in compliance with the current legislation.</p> <p>In addition to the above, Surgutneftegas has no plans for hydrocarbon production in Lake Numto area located within the borders of the protected area of the park where exploration and production of mineral resources is prohibited.</p> <p>All existing and future facilities of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC within the park are located only in the business activity zone where exploration and production of mineral resources is not prohibited.</p> <p>Environmental authorities lodged no claims against the activities of Surgutneftegas within the park in 2016; there were no cases of violation of environmental legislation as well as regimes of functional areas of Numto nature park.</p> <p>Film clips and media publications about the activities of</p> |

Numto nature park is a positive example of cooperation between indigenous people and subsoil users. Scientific researches confirm absence of significant man-made impact on the ecosystem of the Park.</p> <p>“Surgutneftegas” PJSC constantly interacts with indigenous people living within the Park, including Numto national village. There are no claims or discontent of residents, related to the Company’s operation in the Park, including changes in land-use planning of the Park.</p> <p>In accordance with socio-economic agreements with Beloyarsky District and Administration of the Park, the Company granted more than RUB 215 million over 13 years to representatives of the small-numbered indigenous peoples of the North living within Numto nature park. This amount includes allowances and costs of construction of village hall in Numto village, Park’s visitor center, pre-fabricated</p> |

All facilities of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC are located at a significant distance.</p> <p>Upon the initiative of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC working groups in municipalities that take part in considering all issues from representatives of the small-numbered indigenous peoples of the North were created. | 12 | 20.03.2017 | <p>Greenpeace of Russia approached the UN experts with a letter on the rights of indigenous peoples regarding the situation with shaman S.Kechimov, who protests against the activity of Surgutneftegas within the area of lake Imlor.</p> <p>On March 20, 2017, Greenpeace of Russia started the collection of signatures under the joint letter to the team of the UN experts on the rights of indigenous peoples, which calls attention to the criminal case against the representative of Khanty peoples – Sergey Kechimov (shaman and keeper of Sacred Lake Imlor) initiated after his repeated attempts to record law infringements of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC, which performs its activity within the area of the lake.</p> <p>In February 2017, Surgut district court of KhMAO found Sergei Kechimov guilty of murder threat in autumn 2014 against the employees of Surgutneftegas who worked within the area of lake Imlor, sacred to Khanty and Mansy. Moreover, he shot the dog of one of the employees. Kechimov was sentenced to community service, but was freed from the penalty based on the act of amnesty in connection with the 70th anniversary of the Victory in the Great Patriotic War. Kechimov did not plead guilty. He believes</p> | <p>The criminal case against S.V.Kechimov, was brought under Article 119 of Criminal Code of the Russian Federation upon the murder threat against the citizen. “Surgutneftegas” PJSC is not a participant in this criminal case. Due to requirements the Code of Criminal Procedure of the Russian Federation, in cases of said category legal persons do not participate in criminal procedure, because the object of the offense in this case is citizen's life and health. Criminal cases under Article 119 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation are not criminal cases of private prosecution and are opened where there is any information and without victim-impact statement. “Surgutneftegas” PJSC is irrelevant to this case and was not involved in preliminary investigation on this case and does not possess any information on the case.</p> <p>Actions of Greenpeace of Russia and S.V.Kechimov in the attempt to associate the activity of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC within the area of lake Imlor with the criminal offence of Kechimov were aimed at the PR campaign to the benefit of Greenpeace of Russia and avoidance or reduction of criminal penalty for S.V.Kechimov.</p> <p>Statement of the fact that the dog, killed by S.V.Kechimov belonged to the employee of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC is an absurd that lacks evidence and rational explanation of how it was established that the dog belonged to the employee of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC. Also, there is no evidence that the dog actually killed the deer.</p> <p>At the facilities and within the area of activity of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC, including the vicinity of the cultural heritage site of local significance, the sightseeing attraction “Sacred Lake Imlor”, employees of “Surgutneftegas” PJSC are forbidden to keep or feed dogs and wild animals.
